

# Course Descriptions

## Trike Riders Course (TRC)

Focusing on the dynamics of three-wheel riding, the TRC helps Trike riders understand how their vehicle will react in a variety of street/road situations and then test those assumptions on the range. Like all GWRRA Rider Courses, this course also focuses on 'mental riding' as well as the braking, cornering and swerving skills of the rider and co-rider. This course has both a classroom (3 hrs) and range (4hrs) requirement. (12 trike limit)

There is a range-only version of this course available for recertification in the GWRRA Levels Program.

## Trike with Trailer Rider Course (TTRC)

By completing the TTRC, riders and co-riders become aware of the effects of pulling a trailer on the handling and operating characteristics of the Trike. It remains focused on the basic skills of braking, cornering and swerving while addressing the dynamics related to having a trailer attached.

There is a range-only version of this course available for recertification in the GWRRA Levels Program. (12 trike limit)

## Course Descriptions

### Advanced Rider Course (ARC)

The ARC course allows GWRRA to provide local training opportunities where other professional motorcycle safety courses may not be available or affordable. This course has both a classroom (3 hrs) covering 'mental riding' and proactive riding, and range excersizes (4 hrs) covering turning, swerving and breaking.

We encourage Co-riders to take part in all our Rider Courses. It's important for the co-rider to know what the Rider is doing and why. This way the Rider and Co-rider can "Ride as a Team" for the ultimate in Safety and Enjoyment!

There is a range-only version of this course available for recertification in the GWRRA Levels Program. (12 bike limit)

- ✓ All Ohio GWRRA Classes may be ridden 2-Up. Ride as a Team for the ultimate in Safety & Enjoyment!
- ✓ All Makes & Model Motorcycles, Trikes & Trailers permitted.
- ✓ Rider/Co-Rider do NOT have to be a GWRRA Member to participate.
- ✓ Riders/Co-Riders must wear full protective Gear.
- ✓ Riders must have valid operator's license with motorcycle endorsement and proof of insurance for the motorcycle. THESE DOCUMENTS WILL BE ASKED FOR AT THE BEGINNING OF THE CLASS. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE THEM YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE CLASS.
- ✓ You will be notified of class details the Monday prior to class via email.
- ✓ Courses will take place rain or shine. NO refunds due to weather.
- ✓ Cost for all courses is \$35.00 per bike or trike. Make checks payable to "GWRRA of Ohio"
- ✓ Please return form No Later than 2 weeks prior to your chosen class. Early Registration assures your participation in the class of your choice.
