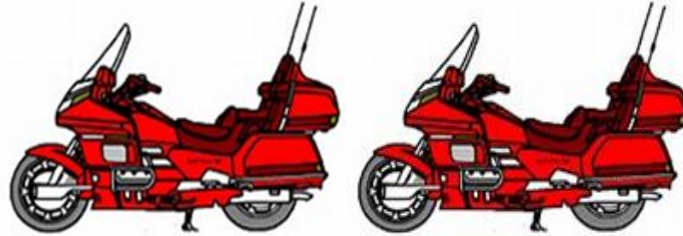

Roundabouts
